Types of Gemstone Lustre

In the mineral world, lustre comes in two main types: non-metallic and metallic. In addition, an intermediate type, sub-metallic, is sometimes used as a description. However, the gem industry most commonly deals with the non-metallic varieties. Most gems do not meet the criteria for metallic or sub-metallic lustre.

Adamantine

This term describes gems with a brilliant, mirror-like appearance, like Diamonds.

Vitreous

Most gemstones, including popular jewellery species like Quartz, Topaz, and Tourmaline, have a shiny, "glass-like" lustre. In some reference works, you may encounter "glassy" as another term for this type of lustre.

Pearly

Gems with this type of lustre have surfaces that look like that of pearls. Some may even show iridescent colours on their surfaces, like the orient of Pearls. Gypsum and Charoite may show pearly lustre.

Silky

Some gems, like Ulexite, show fine parallel threads that look like the texture of fabric. This is known as a silky lustre.

Greasy

Gems with a greasy lustre seem to have a layer of oil or fat on their surface. Examples of this lustre include Graphite and green Serpentine.

Resinous

Amber consists literally of preserved prehistoric plant resin. Therefore, it should come as no surprise that this gem material has a resinous lustre. Sphalerite gems may have a resinous lustre, too.

Waxy

Gems that may show this lustre, like Turquoise and Opal, appear to have a layer of wax on their surface.

Dull

A dull lustre simply means a gemstone reflects little light, such as Rhodonite or Kaolinite.

Metallic

Metallic lustre, a reflective metal-like appearance, is a term not usually used for gemstones. Haematite, however, is a notable exception. It has a striking, metallic sheen, and gem cutters have carved cameos and made beads from this material.

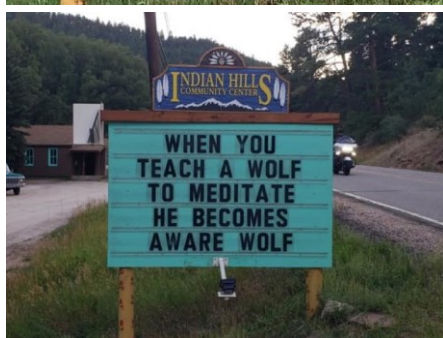
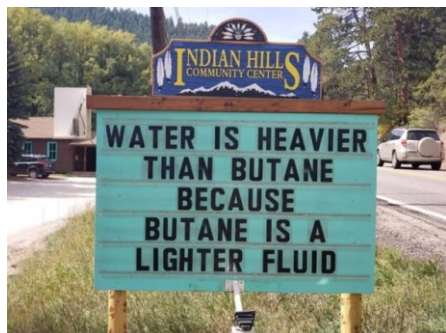
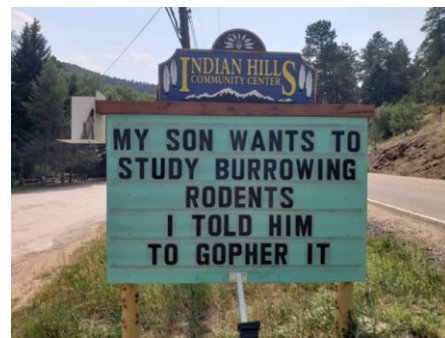
Medical experts in London today were asked if it is time to ease the COVID lockdowns...

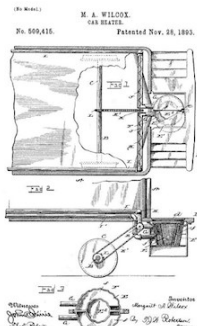

Fascinating Inventions by Women

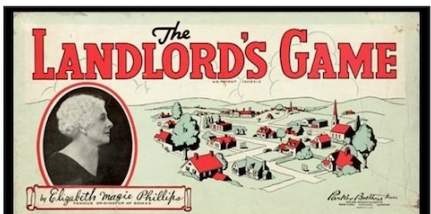

1. The Car Heater



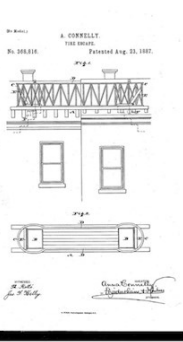
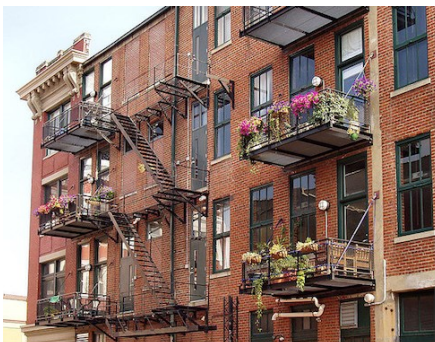
We all owe our thanks to Margaret A Wilcox who invented the car heater in 1893! (Margaret also invented a combined clothes and dishwasher.)

2. Monopoly



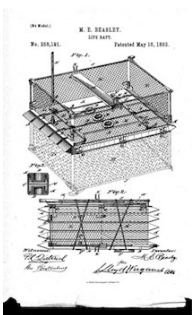

4. The Life Raft



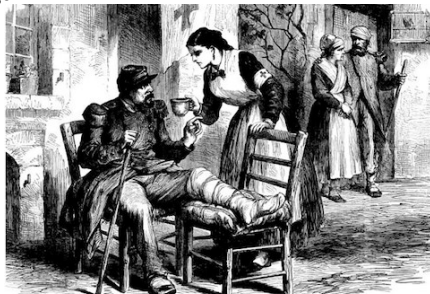
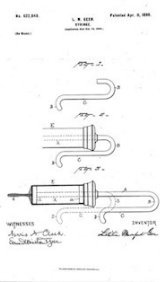
The lifesaving Life Raft was invented by Maria Beasley in 1882. (Maria also invented a machine that makes barrels.)

6. The Medical Syringe



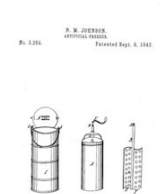
The medical syringe which could be operated with only one hand was invented by a woman by the name of Letitia Geer in 1899.

The ice cream maker was invented by a woman named Nancy Johnson in 1843. Her patented design is still used today!

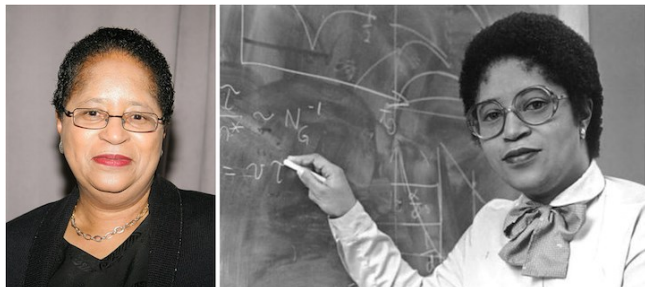
9. The Computer Algorithm

10. Telecommunications Technology



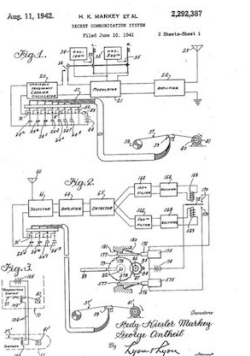

11. The Dishwasher



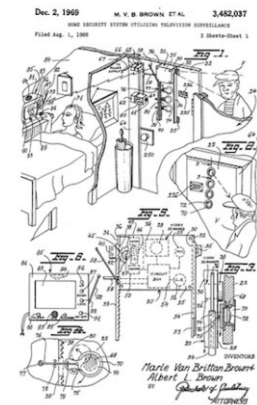
The Dishwasher was invented by Josephine Cochrane in 1887. Before her time, she even marketed her machine to hotel owners and even opened her own factory without the help of a man!

12. Wireless Transmission Technology



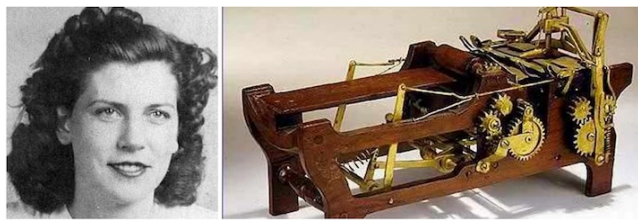

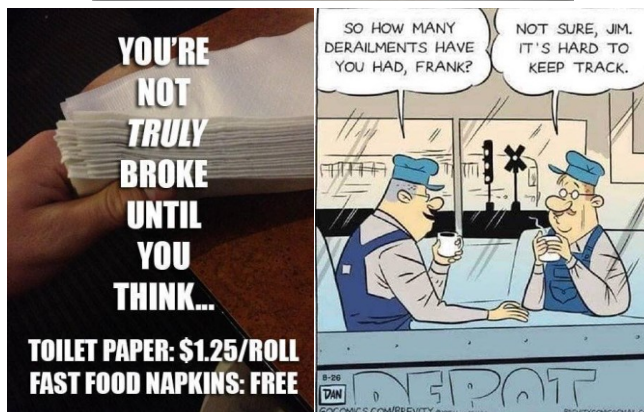
14. The Modern Paper Bag
